JUDGMENT

1. The above named accused has been sent up to face trial for the offence punishable under Section 269 of BNS., by the Station House Officer of Police Station Sector-29, Panipat.

2. The present case was registered against the accused on the order dated 20.05.2025 passed by Sh. Yogesh Chaudhry, Ld. ASJ, Panipat passed in case title Narender @ Golu NDPS-81-2022. The investigation was pressed into action which was carried out by HC Raj Kumar. Statements of witnesses were recorded. After completion of investigation and other usual formalities of the case, challan was filed in the Court for trial of accused under Section 269 of BNS.

3. Copy of challan was supplied to the accused free of costs as envisaged under Section 230 of BNSS.

4. Charge under Section 269 of BNS., was framed upon the accused vide order dated **17.02.2026** by the Court of undersigned, to which he pleaded not guilty and claimed trial. However, on **24.07.2026, i.e., today**, he volunteered to confess his guilt. He is given time to think over the same and also explained that he is not bound to suffer any such statement of confessing the crime. Also, that if he confess the crime, such a statement can be used against him. Despite giving sufficient time to think over again, he volunteered to confess his guilt. Accordingly his statement recorded.

5. The accused Narender @ Golu has stated at bar that he is making confession voluntarily without any inducement or pressure. Therefore, I have the reason to believe that the confession by the accused has been made voluntarily. Accordingly the accused is held guilty and convicted under Section 269 of BNS. Let, he be heard on the quantum of sentence.

1. Heard on the point of quantum of sentence.

The accused be released, if not required in any another case. Case property be dealt with in accordance with law after the expiry of period of appeal or revision. File be consigned to the record-room after due compliance.
