ORDER

1. The report of the Nazir has already been received, wherein it has been reported that as per record Register No.141/50, an amount of Rs.25,60,233/- has been deposited vide R.D. No.14150166 dated 14.07.2014 in MACT Case No.113/2011 titled as Charanjeet Kaur Vs. Sandeep Singh & others, out of the total amount, voucher for an amount of Rs.5,12,046/- had been issued in the name of Navjot Kaur (minor) daughter of Bhupinder Singh in the shape of FDR till the majority of minor child as per award dated 02.01.2014.

2. Report of the concerned Ahlmad has also been received. As per the report of the concerned Ahlmad, no stay has been received in this case.

3. Heard on the application filed by the applicant/claimant no.4 Navjot Kaur for release of FDR.

4. It is contended by the counsel for the applicant/claimant no.4 Navjot Kaur that the above said claim petition was decided by the Court of Sh. Dilbagh Singh Johal, the then Id. Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, SAS Nagar on 02.01.2014 and share of the claimant no.4 Navjot Kaur was ordered to be deposited in the shape of FDR as she was minor at that time. Now the claimant no.4 has attained the age of majority and her date of birth is 12.02.2004. No useful purpose will be

served by keeping the said amount in the shape of FDR as the applicant is in need of money.

5. In support of his claim, the applicant has placed on file copy of her school certificate, copy of her PAN Card and copy of her aadhar card, in which her date of birth is mentioned as 12.02.2004. Therefore, this Court is satisfied that applicant/claimant no.4 Navjot Kaur has attained majority at present. Therefore, the amount of Rs.5,12,046/- deposited in the shape of FDR as per report of Nazir, falling to the share of the applicant/claimant no.4 Navjot Kaur alongwith interest accrued thereon, is ordered to be released to her, in terms of Award dated 02.01.2014 passed by the Court of Sh. Dilbagh Singh Johal, the then Learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, SAS Nagar, on furnishing of identity proof and other relevant documents etc. The copy of this order be sent to the Branch Manager, State Bank of Patiala (Now State Bank of India), Chandigarh Distt. Court Service Block, 1st Floor, District Court Complex, Sector 43, Chandigarh for information and necessary compliance. The present petition is disposed of accordingly. File be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
