:: ORDER BELOW EXH.1 ::

Read the application. Heard, the Learned Advocates for the parties. Having gone through the contents of the application and in view of the **compromise award** passed in above stated claim petition, as well as the endorsement made by the Registry that the awarded amount of **Rs.20,000/-** has been deposited with this Tribunal. Hence, in view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I find no impediment to disburse the amount as awarded by the Tribunal in the impugned order. Hence, in view of the fact that the matter is settled in the Lok Adalat, I find no impediment to disburse the amount as compromised between the parties and award passed by the Tribunal on the basis of the compromise arrived between the parties. As per the provision laid down in Sec.21(1), Chapter VI of the Legal Services Authority Act, 1987, No Court Fees Stamp is to be deducted as this claim petition has been settled in National Lok-Adalat. In view of the above, I pass the following order :

- 1 The Registry/ Nazir concerned, is hereby directed to pay the amount of Rs.20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) by RTGS/ NEFT, by following the instruction given in the Notification (paripatra) regarding the payment in the compromised matters after due verification.
- 2 No order as to costs.
