

M.A.C.M.A. No.94/2026**(In M.A.C.P. No.335/2015)****: ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 :**

- (1) The applicant has preferred present application under provision of Section -151, Order 24, Rule 4(2) of the Code of Civil Procedure for amendment in the name of his father mentioned in award and disbursement of compensation amount.
- (2) The applicant has preferred M.A.C.P. No.335/2015, to get compensation as he has sustained injuries due to vehicular accident occurred on 16.01.2007. The Tribunal has passed judgment and award on 12.11.2025, and as per the order passed by the Tribunal, the Opponent has deposited the awarded amount. Moreover, the applicant has also prayed for correction in the name of his father. The applicant has also specified his full correct name as follow:

- (3) The Opponent has not remained present or filed any objection for allowing this application.
- (4) The present application was filed by the applicant in which he has prayed to make correction in the name of his father and also produced copies of Aadhar Card, PAN Card and Bank Passbook vide Mark 3/1 & 3/3 respectively to show his actual full name and surname.

- (5) Having considered the nature of the amendment as sought for, it transpires that by allowing the said amendment the opposite party would not suffer any prejudice and on the contrary, such amendment will make disbursement of the amount of compensation more easier. Further, the Opponents - Insurance Companies have not raised any objection with regard to make such amendment. Therefore, to achieve the object of substantial justice the amendment in the award of M.A.C.P. No.335/2015 is required to be allowed.
- (6) The applicant has also filed this application to pass an order for disbursement of amount of compensation. According to the report of Nazir, it appears that **Rs.7,28,196/- has been deposited vide MACT "C" No.383/25-26.**
- (7) Therefore, looking to the facts and circumstances, stated in the application and considering the documentary evidence produced along with this application, the request appears to be genuine and reasonable. Hence, following order is passed in the interest of justice.

: O R D E R :

- i. The application is hereby allowed.
- ii. Necessary correction be made in the original award drawn in M.A.C.P.No.335/2015, dated 12.11.2025.

- iii. Out of the amount of compensation i.e. Rs.3,28,196/- (Rupees Three Lacs Twenty Eight Thousand One Hundred Ninety Six Only) after deducting requisite Court Fees and/or amount of interim compensation (if any), 30% amount of compensation be paid by RTGS or NEFT in the account of the applicant and remaining 70% amount is ordered to be invested in FDR in her name for a period of 05 (five) years in a nationalized bank with condition that, no loan or any advance shall be given on the aforesaid amount without prior permission of this Tribunal.
- iv. On maturity, the amount of the said investment shall be paid to the applicant without requiring any order of this Tribunal.
- v. Copy of this order be sent to the Nazir for necessary action.
