



M.A.C.M.A. No.229/2026

(In M.A.C.P. No.226/2008)

: ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 :

- (1) The applicants have preferred present application under provision of Section -151, 152, 153 of the Code of Civil Procedure for amendment in their bank account numbers mentioned in their earlier MACMA No. 148/2026.
- (2) The applicants filed M.A.C.P. No.226/2008, to get compensation in view of the sad demise of deceased Vajesinh Jorsinh Damor in an accident occurred on 31.01.2008. The Tribunal has passed judgment and award on 10.10.2013.
- (3) Being aggrieved and dissatisfied with the award passed by the Tribunal the claimants have filed First Appeal No. 177/2014 before the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat, which was allowed by the Hon'ble High Court and enhanced the compensation amount vide order dated 04.08.2025, in this connection the Opponent No.3 - Insurance Company has deposited the amount of Rs. 9,83,257/-. Moreover, the Hon'ble Gujarat High Court has given direction to disburse the entire award amount in favour of the original claimants, after due verification as per the original judgment and award.
- (4) In this regard, the applicants have filed M.A.C.M.A. No. 762/2025, to pass an order for disbursement of amount came to their respective share, from the amount of compensation **Rs.9,83,257/-** deposited vide MACT "C" No.302/25-26. In the said M.A.C.M.A. No. 762/2025, the applicants have also prayed to pass an order for disbursement of amount came to the share of claimant No. 6 in MACP No.226/2008 who was died during

the pendency of the appeal filed by them before the Hon'ble High Court. In this regard the claimant No.2 - Rajesh Vajesinh Damor has filed his affidavit vide Exh.4 and declared that he has no objection if the amount came to the share of claimant No.6 be disbursed amongst the present applicants and the applicants have also produce the death certificate of Claimant No.5 - Jorsinh Narsinh Damor.

- (5) Therefore, considering the facts, the Tribunal has allowed the M.A.C.M.A. No.762/2025 and passed an order for amendment as well as for disbursement of the amount of compensation.
- (6) Then after deducting the amount of Court Fees, the Tribunal has deposited the amount in the accounts of the applicants, but, the Bank Authorities have not deposited such amount in the applicants account, therefore, the applicants have deposited Rs.2,11,623/- vide 'C' No. 432-1/25-26, Rs.2,11,623/- vide 'C' No. 432-2/25-26 and Rs.5,53,473/- vide 'C' No. 432-3/25-26, Total Rs. 9,76,719/- (the amount after deduction of Court Fees amount). Hence, the applicants have filed an application vide MACMA No. 148/2026 to pass an order for disbursement of amount came to their respective share, from the amount of compensation **Rs.9,76,719/-** deposited vide MACT "C" No.432/25-26, but, in the MACMA No. 148/2026 due to bonafide mistake the applicants mentioned wrong account numbers, therefore to rectify the account numbers the present applicants filed this application and also produced their respective bank accounts as under.
