The record is put up for moving application for ad-interim injunction U/O 39 rule 1 and 2 read with section 151 C.P.C supported by an affidavit.

Put up considered and allowed.

No caveat is pending as per the notes of sheristedar.

Perused the record.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the plaintiffs.

The plaintiff case is that the plaintiffs got the suit property from by way of purchase, their names recorded in the LRROR. The defendant is stranger having no right, title and interest and possession over suit property disturbing peaceful possession of the plaintiff over the suit property.

Hence, plaintiff are praying for ad interim injunction restraining defendants from disturbing peaceful possession of the plaintiffs over the suit property and /or not to cause waste and damage to the suit property.

Perused petition and documents filed by the plaintiff.

On perusal of the record and documents prima face it appears that the plaintiff may have some right in respect to suit property. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and regard being had to the urgency involved in the matter, in the meantime, this Court inclined to allow the ad interim order of injunction.

Hence,

ORDERED

that the application for ad-interim injunction U/O 39 rule 1 and 2 read with section 151 C.P.C is considered and allowed.

Defendant no. 1 is hereby directed not disturb peaceful possession of the plaintiffs over the suit property till 16.07.2026.

The Defendant is directed to show cause within 15 days from the date of receipt thereof as to why prayer of temporary injunction of the plaintiff shall not be allowed.

Plaintiff is directed to comply with the provision Order XXXIX Rule 3 (a) & 3(b) of CPC.

Issue notice upon the Defendants at once.
