Earlier bail and surety bonds of the accused stands discharged. Necessary intimation be sent to the concerned authority for release of the surety bonds in this case. The case property, if any, be dealt with as per Rules after expiry of period of appeal/revision if any or after its disposal. File be consigned to record room, after due compliance.
