

**SUIT FOR DECLARATAION, PERMANENT AS WELL AS
MANDATORY INJUNCTION AND SPECIFIC PERFORMANCE**

- (1) Whether the plaintiff proves that he invested total amount of Rs. 1,40,94,385/- for setting up of Jay Gurudev Petroleum and had a clear, unequivocal understanding with defendant nos. 1,2 that no.1 would only be its dealer on paper and plaintiff would have 60% share in profit whereas defendant no.1 would have 15% and no.2 would have 25%?*
- (2) Whether the plaintiff proves that defendant nos. 1,2 had signed the partnership deed with plaintiff but then changed their minds and betrayed the plaintiff in collusion with defendant nos. 5 to 7?*
- (3) Whether the defendant no.1 to 7 prove that plaintiff has not invested the alleged amount in setting up of disputed petrol pump and misutilized the funds of profit for which defendant no.1 had given a public notice apprising the public not to enter into any sort of deal with plaintiff in name of petrol pump?*
- (4) Whether the defendant no.1 proves that her signature over the unregistered partnership deed is forged by plaintiff and she has never executed any such document?*
- (5) Whether the defendants prove that plaintiff's suit is insufficiently stamped and this Court does not have pecuniary jurisdiction to adjudicate it?*
- (6) Whether the plaintiff is entitled to get the reliefs as prayed for?*
- (7) What order and decree?*
