- (3)** *Whether plaintiffs prove that alleged sale deed is executed by breach of provisions of Transfer of Property Act, Power of Attorney Act, Indian Registration Act and Contract Act?*
- (4)** *Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to get the reliefs as prayed for?*
- (5)** *What order and decree?*
