

**order below Ex.1**

(1) Today, the present motor accident claim petition is placed before National Lok-Adalat for find out the possibilities of amicable settlement between the parties. The applicant, along-with Ld. Adv and Ld. Advocate on behalf of opponent Insurance Co. with special power to settle the matter are present and they have submitted compromise pursis at Ex. 52. They have submitted that matter is amicably settled and applicant has agreed to accept Rs.50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lac only) as full and final settlement and also agrees to waive claim for the rest of the amount in the present petition and accordingly opponent Insurance Co. is also agreed to pay the said amount towards full and final settlement of claim in the petition. It is also agreed to the applicant that claim against opponent no. 1 stands disposed off.

(2) It has been also agreed between parties that amount if, any paid under no fault liability including interest shall have to be deducted from the compromise amount agreed above.

(3) Opponent Insurance Co. is hereby agreed to deposit the said amount within six months from today and failing on which Insurance co. will be liable to pay interest at 6 % per annum from the date of default realization.

(4) On depositing the said amount before Tribunal 50 % amount be invested in 5 years FDR in any nationalised bank of applicant's choice and remaining 50 % amount be paid to applicant by issuing A/c. payee cheque in the name of applicant.

(5) The parties to bear their own costs.

(6) Award be drawn accordingly.

(7) As, the present matter is settled in National Lok-Adalat, if any amount paid by the Applicants towards Court Fee is ordered to refund to applicant by issuing Court-Fee refund certificate in the name of applicant.

The above order is pronounced today in National Lok-Adalat.
