

THE MOTOR ACCIDENT CLAIM TRIBUNAL-
GANDHINAGAR

ORDER BELOW M.A.C.M.A. No.101 OF 2026

(M.A.C.P. NO.15 of 2016)

(In Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat R/F.A. No. 1447 of 2021)

- In view of the judgment/order passed in above claim petition, the following order is passed for disbursement of deposited amount:
- Awarded Amount : Rs.3,93,500=00.
- Date of Award : 26.08.2020.
- As per direction of Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat in C.A. No.01 of 2021 in F.A No. 1447 of 2021, this tribunal has passed order dated 10.01.2022 in MACMA No. 314 of 2021 in M.A.C.P. No. 15 of 2016 in which 30% from awarded amount has been disbursed and 70% has been fixed deposited in favour of Original claimants.
- The Original FDRs in the name of Applicants are retained by Nazir, as per endorsement made by Nazir..
- **As per the Order passed by Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat in First Appeal No.1447 of 2021, Dated 05.12.2025.**

Oral Order

“ Learned advocate for the respondents pointed out that the captioned appeal may not deserve the consideration on merits owing to the smallness of the amount awarded to the claimants. It is noticed that the learned Tribunal has awarded amount of Rs.3,93,500/- to the claimants. This is a small and meager amount and considering the aspect of having no dispute in regards to the road accident, I am of the opinion that this appeal may not deserve consideration, more particularly, on the ground of smallness of amount. Accordingly, present first appeal stands dismissed.

It is made clear that present first appeal is dismissed on account of smallness of the amount and the order passed by this Court shall not be treated as precedent so as to say that this Court has decided any issue on merit. The whole purpose to dismiss the appeal on account of smallness of amount is with a view to avoid hardship both physically and financially on the part of the original claimants to appear and defend the case.

Therefore, this order shall not be cited as precedent in any pending matters before any Court in the State of Gujarat.

If any amount of compensation, or any statutory amount, lying deposited with the Registry of this Court shall be transmitted to the learned Tribunal concerned.

R & P, if any, to be sent back to the concerned Court immediately. The entire award amount be disbursed and released in favour of claimant/s after due verification by transferring said amount/s to the account/s of claimant/s by RTGS or NEFT.

The appellant is at liberty to revive the appeal in case of difficulty.

ORDER

The Nazir is directed to return FDRs to the applicants after due verification as mentioned below and necessary yadi be made to the bank.
