It also appears from the report that after enquiry by Cyber Crime P.S. that Rs. 20300/- is put on hold in Overseas Bank A/C No. 179201000013264 IFSC Code IOBA0001792.

It also appears that SI concerned of Cyber Crime P.S., CBR has prayed for necessary order upon the Branch Manager, Indian Overseas Bank, Kursi Road, Lucknow to refund the amount of Rs. 20300/- to the bank account of the petitioner Rasida Begum in her Central Bank A/C No. 5471094995, IFSC Code CBIN0281032.

In view of the report I am inclined to pass necessary direction upon the Branch Manager, Indian Overseas Bank, Kursi Road, Lucknow accordingly.

Hence, let the duped money of Rs. 20300/- be returned to the petitioner Rasida Begum in her Central Bank A/C No. 5471094995, IFSC Code CBIN0281032 from Overseas Bank A/C No. 179201000013264 IFSC Code IOBA0001792.
