ORDER

The present Case has been filed under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

The record reveals that the applicant/complainant was duly served with the notice of the present proceedings. Even after the service of notice, she remained absent before the Court.

Today, when the matter was called out repeatedly, neither the applicant/complainant nor her learned advocate remained present before the Court. No application seeking adjournment or exemption from appearance has been filed.

The record further reveals that the applicant/complainant has remained absent from the proceedings for a considerable period, and sufficient opportunities have already been granted by this Court to prosecute the present proceedings. Despite such opportunities, the applicant/complainant has failed to remain present or to take necessary steps for prosecuting the matter.

The continuous absence of the applicant/complainant despite due service of notice and repeated opportunities clearly indicates that she is no longer interested in prosecuting the present proceedings. No sufficient cause has been shown for today's absence. This Court is, therefore, of the considered opinion that the applicant/complainant has abandoned the present proceedings. Keeping the matter pending indefinitely would serve no useful purpose.

Accordingly, The present application filed under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 is hereby dismissed for default and for want of prosecution.
