



1 Today, in the National Lok Adalat, compromise pursis is filed by the respective parties through their learned Advocates with regard to settlement of their disputes as described in the main petition. Today, on being inquiring upon, the parties have admitted the contents of this compromise pursis when read over and explained to them. Therefore, in terms of settlement this compromise pursis is taken on records and recorded. The parties have arrived at a compromise to settle the claim for **Rs.13,50,000/- (Rupees Thirteen Lacs Fifty Thousands Only)**, as the opponent No.3-insurer is agreed to pay such amount to the claimants, therefore, the claim against the opponent nos.1 & 2 stands disposed of as per compromise pursis.

2 The amount of interim compensation, if any paid, be deducted from the final amount of the award.

3 On depositing the entire amount of award, both the claimants being parents of deceased, are equally [50% to each claimant] entitled to get the amount of compensation, firstly, Rs.2,00,000/- be paid to the claimants in cash by way of account payee cheque upon proper identification and verification, and from the remaining amount, 40% amount be paid to the claimants in cash by Account Payee Cheque upon proper identification and verification and remaining 60% amount be invested in any Nationalized Bank for their choice in their name for the period of Five (5) years in fixed deposit with instructions to the Bank not to flow any loan over it and not make any other regarding cash credit or anything over it. However, the claimants are entitled to have periodical interest on it.

4 The Bank shall intimate to this Tribunal particulars of the Fixed Deposit such as date of the Fixed Deposit such as date on investment. Number of F. D. Receipt, date of maturity together with authentic copy of F.D.R. immediately after issuing F.D.R.

5 No order as to costs.

6 This claim petition is settled in this National Lok Adalat therefore, as provided in Sec.17 of the Legal Service Authority Act the amount of court fees, if paid, shall be returned back by way of issuing necessary court fees refund certificate.

7 Award be drawn accordingly.

8 This claim petition stands disposed of accordingly.
