

Order Below Application Exh.1
in MACP No. 9 of 2024.

1. The petitioner has filed this petition for obtaining compensation of Rs.8,00,000/- under the provisions of Section 166 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 (Hereinafter referred in short as “the M. V. Act”).
2. The notices were dully served upon the Respondents and they have appeared before the Tribunal through their Ld. Advocates.
3. Having perused the entire record of this claim petition, it appears that the matter is pending for producing of evidence on the part of the petitioner since long, but the petitioner did not turned up before this Tribunal for production of evidence in this matter. The record clearly shows that the petitioner has remained constantly absent and therefore, the Ld. Advocate for the opponents filed application Exh.28 to dismiss for default the present application of the petitioner. Then the petitioner has been served summons/Notice for appearance in the Tribunal. But neither the petitioner nor his advocate appear before the Tribunal. Therefore, it appears that the petitioner does not want to proceed with the petition. Hence, the present claim petition is required to be dismissed on account of default and non-appearance of the present petitioner. Accordingly, the present claim petition is required to be dismissed. Hence, following final Order is passed.
