ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application having been filed by applicant-accused for grant of bail in view of provisions of Section 483 of BNSS in above noted FIR.
2. Notice of the application was issued to the State. Police record was produced and perused.
3. Learned counsel for accused/applicant filed application for addition of Sections 336, 338, 336(2), 340, 204, 205 BNS in the head note of the bail application which is considered and allowed as

learned APP for the State suffered the statement that he has no objection in case the application in question is allowed. Learned counsel also filed amended head note of the bail application and submitted that accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It has been contended that accused/applicant was arrested on 07.03.2026 and since then she is in judicial custody. He contended that the investigation and trial would take considerable long time and custody of accused for this long and indefinite period will serve no useful purpose rather it would cause great hardship upon accused. Accordingly, he has prayed for concession of bail to the applicant.

4. On the other hand learned Additional PP for the State has opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations against the accused/applicant are serious and she has been repeatedly indulging in commission of offence of similar nature. In this regard, he referred to two FIRs no.38 dated 16.03.2024 P.S. Civil Lines Amritsar and FIR no.40 dated 03.04.2025 of P.S. Civil Lines Amritsar. He prayed that the present bail application be dismissed.

5. Rival contentions of both the sides have been heard and the record has been perused with due care and circumspection.

6. ASI William Masih No.3226/BTL, Police Station Dera Baba Nanak appeared and suffered his statement to the effect that no other bail application of accused/applicant is pending in any court in

this FIR. He stated that offence under sections 336/338/336(2)/340/204/205 BNS were added in this FIR later on. He stated that accused/applicant impersonated her as police Inspector and threatened the complainant and prepared forged ID cards. He stated that she is also involved in two other FIRs under IPC.

7. Perusal of police record reflects that the present FIR was registered on the statement of complainant Tarlok Singh dated 07.03.2026. Tarlok Singh stated that he is an agriculturist. He stated that he has three children. One of his children i.e. son Harpinder Singh is residing in Canada whereas his two daughters Manbir Kaur and Jasbir Kaur as well as his son Harpinder Singh are married. He stated that his wife Balbir Kaur expired on 04.12.2025 and he resides alone at his home. He stated that on 26.02.2026 at about 07:35 PM, his cousin Jagmohan Singh Bath received a call on his mobile no.9914847773 from telephone no.9780531002. The caller disclosed that she is Ramandeep Randhawa, Police Inspector calling from District Amritsar (Rural). The caller enquired about the second marriage solemnized by Sukhjeevan Singh son of Balwinder Singh. The complainant stated that since Ramandeep Randhawa was calling time and again to his brother, hence he talked to the person on his mobile no.9780531002 from his phone no.9814354462. The said caller again enquired about the second marriage solemnized by Sukhjeevan Singh resident of Village Panwan. Complainant stated

that he informed the said caller that Sukhjeevan Singh had not solemnized any second marriage. The complainant stated that thereafter Ramandeep Randhawa started harassing them by portraying herself as fake Police Inspector by complaining at Control Room Batala on helpline no.112. She used to harass him and his brother Jagmohan Singh Bath and she would say that she wants to help said Sukhjeevan Singh who is serving in Army and is having dispute with his wife who want to take divorce from each other. She asked for money to get settled their dispute and otherwise she will get implicated Sukhjeevan Singh and the complainant party in a false case. She threatened to teach a lesson to Ranjot Singh Chairman who is brother of complainant. Complainant further stated that on 04.03.2026, ASI Lakhwinder Singh got call from mobile no.9780531002 from Inspector Ramandeep Randhawa who asked complainant and Jagmohan Bath to come present at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak at 04:00 PM. Complainant stated that they visited Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, however Inspector Ramandeep Randhawa did not turn up there. Complainant stated that they enquired about the matter and came to know that said Ramandeep Randhawa is fake Inspector. Complainant further stated that on 07.03.2026, she called her elder brother Ranjot Singh Bath Chairman who got telephone call from ASI Lakhwinder Singh that Ramandeep Randhawa would come on that day at Adda Zhanghi Panwan.

Ramandeep Randhawa and others were asked to come there. Ramandeep Randhawa (fake name) also informed Raman Kumar Head Munshi of P.S. Dera Baba Nanak that she is Inspector of Punjab Police from Amritsar (Rural). Complainant stated that infact the name of said caller is Ranjit Kaur @ Rani wife of Harpal Singh d/o Balkar Singh. She sent her photo on his phone, however she does not appear to be Inspector of Police from her photograph. He stated that Ramandeep Randhawa had threatened him by portraying as lady Inspector of Punjab Police. He prayed for taking legal action against the accused.

8. Perusal of police record reveals that one FIR No.38 dated 16.03.2024 of P.S. Civil Lines Amritsar was also lodged against the present accused wherein she met with an accident and accused portrayed herself as Inspector Ramandeep Kaur Randhawa and asked the police party to get her compensated as the left side mirror of her BMW car had broken whereas she was not posted as Reader Staff or in the District, whereas she had disclosed that she is Ramandeep Kaur Randhawa from Punjab Police and she posted as Reader of SSP, Amritsar (Rural). The perusal of the another FIR No.40 dated 03.04.2025 P.S. Civil Lines Amritsar shows that she had disclosed her name as Simrandeep Kaur Randhawa and projected herself as SHO in Punjab Police. On being enquired about her belt no.1288-R/ASR, it emerged that it pertained to some other official.

9. The said FIRs are of year 2024 and 2025 whereas the present FIR pertains to 07.03.2026 which shows that the accused/applicant is repeatedly committing the offence of the similar nature that too within short span of time. Her act and conduct thus does not warrant taking of lenient view against such habitual offender who has not been desisting from committing the offence of similar nature time and again and is repeating act and conduct of similar nature. Hence, present bail application is hereby dismissed. Trial court record be returned. Record of present bail application be consigned to record room.
