ORDER:

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application moved by applicant/accused for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 79 dated 05.03.2025 U/s 109, 118 (1), 3 (5) of BNS, Police Station, Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant-accused has argued that a false case has been registered against the accused/applicant and he is in

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judicial custody since his date of arrest and confined in District Jail Pathankot. That as per the FIR no offence is made out against the accused/applicant as per the FIR and nothing has to be recovered from the accused/applicant. The police of Model Town has presented the challan in the presnet case and no useful purpose is going to serve by putting the accused/applicant behind the bar as police has completed the investigation. The prosecution of case and conclusion of trial shall take sufficient long time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. So it is prayed that accused may be released on bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State opposed the bail application on the ground that the applicant/accused is a criminal person as per police record. Even, complainant has specifically levelled the allegations against the accused/applicant. So, if the bail granted to him he can again misuse the bail and spreading the crime in the society. Therefore, he is not entitled to concession of bail and as such, his bail application may kindly be dismissed.

4. I have heard the arguments advanced by Learned counsel for the applicant-accused as well as Learned Public Prosecutor for the State and also perused the police record.

5. Perusal of the file it is clear that the challan in this case has already been presented in the Court and fixed for 18.10.2025. The serious offence under Section 118 (1) of BNS registered against the accused/applicant which is punishable by *imprisonment for life, or*

imprisonment for a term which may extend to ten years, and a fine. Further perusal of the record, the accused/applicant is nominated by name in the present FIR as prime accused. As per MLR total 5 injuries received by the Gurdev Singh husband of the complainant, caused by the present accused/applicant along with co-accused with “*dasti khanda*”. Moreover, the weapon of commission of offence has also been recovered by the police. The accused/applicant committed serious offence in the daylight without any fear in the presence of the *Sangat* at religious place. During the course of argument Ld. APP for the State also disclosed that such offence has also been committed by the accused/applicant previously regarding which number of FIR registered against the accused/applicant and trial pending in this Hon’ble Court. From the above detailed discussion, this court is of the considered opinion that the accused/applicant is a criminal person. So, in view of the seriousness of allegations, gravity of offence and the manner in which offence has been committed no ground is made out to grant the concession of bail to the applicant-accused and if the bail is granted he will get encouraged to commit such offence. Thus, the present bail application filed by applicant-accused **Navjot Singh @Jyoti** is **dismissed**. Papers be attached with the main file.

6. However, the observations made herein shall not be construed as opinion of this Court on the merits of this case.
