This order of mine shall dispose of bail application filed by applicant/accused Dilpreet Singh in FIR No. 138 dated 22.10.2023 under Section 379, 411 of IPC pertaining to PS Amargarh. Notice of this bail application was given to Ld. APP for the state who has contested the same. Record perused. Statement of the IO recorded. Heard.

In brief the allegations of the prosecution that complainant Rajinder Singh made a complaint regarding theft of rice bags on 21.10.2023. On investigation accused/applicant Dilpreet Singh as well as one Jagtar Singh was arrested who got recovered the stolen property.

The accused/applicant Dilpreet Singh in the present case is in custody since 22.10.2022. Recovery has been already effected from the accused. Further statement has been made by HC Amrinder Singh that for the purpose of investigation custody of the accused is not required. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/accused Dilpreet Singh in custody any further. No proof filed on record that if bail is granted accused will influence the witnesses or temper with the evidence. Keeping in view the above said circumstances, accused/applicant is admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety in the like amount. During the period of the bail, the accused/applicant will be bound by the following conditions:-

1. He will assist the I.O. in the early completion of the investigation and will make himself present before I.O. or this court as and

when required.

2. He will file affidavit regarding his address in the court and he will not change his address without the permission of this court or under intimation to this court.

3. He will not try to influence the witnesses in the present case.

Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished today. Papers be annexed with the main file/remand papers.
