ORDER

Applicant Ved Parkash @ Pappu filed the present application  
for grant of regular/interim bail due to Covid-19 disease.

2. Notice of the present bail application was issued to the State  
and in pursuance of that notice, the ld. Addl. PP appeared on behalf of  
the State to contest the present bail application.

3. The ld. counsel for the applicant contended that applicant is  
in custody since 10.09.2019. He is falsely implicated in this case. No

useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant in custody for indefinite period. Challan is already presented and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time. Moreover, the whole world is suffering from disease of Covid-19 and due to this reason, the presence of the applicant is very much required for his family. Besides this, the applicant is more than 62 years of age and he is suffering from various diseases and there is no proper treatment for the applicant in the jail premises. So, the applicant may be released on interim bail.

4. On the other hand, the ld. Additional PP for the State argued that the applicant has committed heinous offence, so he cannot be given the benefit of bail at this stage. The ld. Addl. PP for the State further argued that keeping in view the gravity of offence committed by the applicant, he does not deserve any kind of leniency. Therefore, the present bail application may be dismissed.

5. I have heard the ld. counsel for the applicant, the ld. Addl. PP for the State and have perused the record carefully. The present case was registered on the basis of statement of complainant Raj Kumar @ Raju son of Sukeshwar Yadav resident of Village Chugai Jhangi, District Chitra, Jharkhand at present resident of Flat No.30-A, HIG Flats, Rani Jhansi Road, Ghumar Mandi, Ludhiana, in which, he stated that he is resident of the address stated above and he used to work on the soup stall situated opposite of Khalsa College, Ghumar Mandi, Ludhiana along with his brother Deepak Kumar and that soup stalls belongs to his cousin Niranjana Yadav son of Nanku Yadav resident of Village Sawanu, P.S. Simriya, District Chatra, Jharkhand at present resident of Flat

No.30-A, HIG Flats, Rani Jhansi Road, Ghumar Mandi, Ludhiana. Opposite to their soup stall, there is cycle repair stall of Ved Parkash resident of Gopal Nagar, Haibowal Kalan, Ludhiana. On 08.09.2019 at about 08.00 PM, he (complainant Raj Kumar @ Raju) was present on the said soup stall along with said Deepak Kumar and Niranjan Yadav. Then, Ved Parkash @ Pappu had come to them (complainant Raj Kumar @ Raju and others) and he had asked them to fetch the cold drinks demanded by their customers from the shop of Sheetla Parshad son of Madho Ram resident of Patiala Bank Wali Gali, Ghumar Mandi, Ludhiana situated near the gate of Khalsa College. However, when they (complainant Raj Kumar @ Raju and others) had refused to fetch the cold drinks from the shop of said Sheetla Parshad, then said Ved Parkash @ Pappu had started to argue with them and he had scuffled with them, during which, said Ved Parkash @ Pappu had told them that he would teach them lesson. After about 15-20 minutes, said Ved Parkash @ Pappu along with his nephew Arjun, said Sheetla Parshad and his son Karan had come to his (complainant Raj Kumar @ Raju's) stall and then, the said persons had started to give beatings to them, during which, said Karan had caught hold of said Deepak Kumar and then, said Ved Parkash @ Pappu had given screwdriver blow in the head of said Deepak Kumar with intention to kill him whereas above said Arjun had given beatings to him (complainant Raj Kumar @ Raju) and above said Niranjan Yadav with danda. At the time of said occurrence, above said Sheetla Parshad was instigating said Ved Parkash @ Pappu, Arjun and Karan by raising lalkaras that today, they (complainant Raj

Kumar @ Raju and others) should be taught a lesson. In the meantime, various people had started to gather at the spot, due to which, the above said persons had fled away from the spot along with their respective weapons. Initially, he (complainant Raj Kumar @ Raju) along with said Niranjan Yadav had taken his brother Deepak Kumar to Neuro City Hospital, Gobind Nagar, Ghumar Mandi, Ludhiana, from where, he was referred to DMC and Hospital, Ludhiana. Above said Ved Parkash @ Pappu, Sheetla Parshad, Arjun, in connivance with each other, had given beatings to them (complainant Raj Kumar @ Raju and others). Action may be taken against them. Then, the present case was registered and investigation was initiated, during which, applicant Ved Parkash @ Pappu was arrested. The allegations, against the applicant, are serious in nature. In case, he is given benefit of this bail, then there is every likelihood of his fleeing from justice. Merely the applicant is in judicial custody, is no ground to release him on bail. So, in view of all these facts, circumstances of the case and serious nature of offence, the present application for grant of regular/interim bail due to Covid-19 disease is hereby dismissed without commenting on the merits of the case in any manner. File of this bail application be tagged with the main case file.
