Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff seeks permission to withdraw
his application under Order 20 Rule 13 of CPC.

His statement to this effect is recorded separately.

Said application is dismissed as withdrawn.

Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff submits that the plaintiff
wants to lead further evidence for which he has filed application
under Order 16 Rule 6 of CPC for summoning of record.

He requests that the record be summoned and permission
be given to the plaintiff for leading further evidence.

Ld. LAC appearing for the defendant opposes the
application. He submits that the documents sought to be
summoned has no bearing in the present case.

Arguments are heard and record is perused.

In the application under consideration, the plaintiff has
only stated that copy of the FIR and charge-sheet are essential for
a just decision in the present case.

However, it has not been explained how these documents
are relevant in the present case. It has also not been explained
as to why summoning of the documents could not be sought at a

previous stage when the case was listed for recording of evidence.

Case is now at the stage of final arguments. It has been pending since the year 2017.

In the application, only production of document has been sought. It has not even been clarified that the plaintiff wants to lead further evidence.

For the above reasons, the application under Order 16 Rule 6 of CPC is dismissed.

To come up for final arguments on 16.07.2025.
