ORDER

This order of mine shall decide this application for pre-arrest
bail under section 482 of BNSS, filed in the above noted FIR, on behalf of

applicants.

2. **Heard.** Learned counsel for the applicants/accused submitted that the applicants/accused are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case. Story of the prosecution is highly improbable and unnatural. Custodial interrogation of the applicants/accused is not required as nothing is to be recovered from them. Applicants are ready to join the investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency. Hence, it is prayed that the application be allowed and applicants be given the concession of pre-arrest bail.

3. Contesting arguments, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, submitted that the applicants/accused are not entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail keeping in view the gravity and seriousness of allegations. He prayed for dismissal of the present bail application.

4. As per prosecution version, on 27.11.2025, police party headed by SI/SHO Sukhdarshan Sharma, in connection with patrolling and checking of suspicious persons, was present at Dana Mandi, Bholuwala Road, Faridkot. At about 1.30 AM during the night, an informer appeared and gave information that Kulwinder Singh @ Happy Dakia, son of Bohar Singh, resident of Street No. 2-1/2, Sanjay Nagar, Faridkot, has formed a gang in the name of "Happy Dakia" for committing robberies, snatchings, consumption of intoxicants, rioting and acts of hooliganism, and that they are habitual offenders. Several cases pertaining to fights, quarrels and narcotics have already been registered

against them earlier. On the other hand, Sharanjit Singh @ Sharan @ Kalu, son of Souma Singh, resident of Sanjay Nagar, Street No. 2-1/2, Faridkot, has also formed a gang along with his associates under the name “Kalu Gang”, who are habitual of committing robberies, snatchings, rioting, consuming and selling intoxicants. Both the groups have formed rival gangs and indulge in fights, quarrels and organised crime. They disrupt public peace by pelting bricks and stones, causing damage to public property, water tanks and vehicles, and by being armed with deadly weapons, indulge in rioting, thereby creating terror among the general public. On that day, Kulwinder Singh @ Happy Dakia, Manpreet Singh @ Mota, Jagseer Singh @ Seera and Jaggi, residents of Bholuwala Road, Gobind Nagar, Faridkot, Raji wife of Kulwinder Singh @ Happy Dakia, Abhay and Bona, residents of Sanjay Nagar, Street No. 2-1/2, Faridkot, along with some other unknown boys, are armed with deadly weapons and are indulging in hooliganism by pelting bricks and stones. Similarly, from the other side, Sharanjit Singh @ Kalu @ Sharan, Jashandeep Singh @ Jashan and Souma Singh, residents of Street No. 2-1/2, Sanjay Nagar, Faridkot, Rafiq, resident of Tapa Mandi, District Barnala, Lakhwinder Singh @ Baggi, Sagar and Karan, residents of Nanaksar, Faridkot, Arshdeep Singh @ Arsh, resident of Narayan Nagar, Street No.2, Faridkot, along with some other unknown boys, are armed with deadly weapons, have formed a gang, and are indulging in hooliganism, fighting and rioting, thereby endangering the lives of the general public. If

immediate raid be conducted, both groups, while indulging in fighting and rioting, could be apprehended red handed. Finding the information to be reliable, ruqa was prepared and sent to the police station, on the basis of which present FIR came to be registered against the applicants/accused along with co-accused/non-applicants.

5. During the course of investigation, Investigating agency recorded the statements of Ranjit Kaur wife of Soma Singh, Gurmej Singh alias Kala son of Jarnail Singh and Hardev Singh son of Jarnail Singh, wherein they stated that on the intervening night of 27.11.2025 at about 1:30 AM, a serious violent altercation took place in the street between Iqbal Singh @ Happy Dakia and his associates and the opposite group led by Lakhwinder Singh @ Baggi/Sharnjit Singh @ Kalu, during which both sides indiscriminately pelted bricks and stones at each other, resulting in extensive damage to public and private property in the neighbourhood. Members of the groups forcibly entered residential houses and caused substantial destruction, including damage to Activa scooters, plastic water tanks installed on rooftops, washing machines, geysers, electric boards, water pipes, water motors, floor tiles and portions of roofs, besides damaging water tanks and flooring of several neighbouring houses due to stone pelting. The incident created an atmosphere of fear and panic throughout the locality.

6. Having considered the rival contentions and having gone through the record, this Court is of the view that the incident dated

27.11.2025 was a serious gang related riot between two rival groups armed with deadly weapons. The accused actively participated in indiscriminate stone pelting, forcible house trespass and large scale damage to public and private property, creating terror in the locality. Considering the gravity of the offence, this Court finds no ground to grant the relief of anticipatory bail to the applicants/accused. Accordingly, anticipatory bail application of the applicants/ accused is, hereby, **dismissed**. However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression on merits of the case. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
