ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT – 1

1. Today, when the matter was called out, neither the plaintiff nor his learned advocate remained present. No adjournment application has been submitted on behalf of the plaintiff.
2. It transpires from the record that the present suit is relatively new and was filed on 29/07/2025. Despite this, the plaintiff has not remained present in the Court for prosecuting the matter further, either personally or through his advocate, on several dates.
3. It further appears from the record that the summons issued to Defendant No. 2/4 – Ramilaben Pravinbhai Kanajadeja has been returned unserved with the

endorsement that she is not residing at the address mentioned in the process, as reflected from the bailiff report produced vide Exhibit 30. Despite the same, the plaintiff has not taken any steps to furnish a fresh or correct address of the said defendant.

4. From the overall conduct of the plaintiff, it appears that the plaintiff is not interested in prosecuting the present suit.
5. Hence, the following order is passed:

ORDER

1. The present Regular Civil Suit No. 23 of 2025 is hereby dismissed for default.
2. No order as to costs.
