

State Vs. Shamsher Singh. 27-2021.

Bail application put up before me. Perusal of file shows that a FIR No.63 dated 05.03.2021, Police Station Ajnala, has been registered against the accused Shamsher Singh U/S 61-1-14 of Excise Act.

Notice of the bail application was issued to the learned APP for the state. He appeared and contested the bail application orally and did not wish to file reply and stated that offence committed by accused are grave in nature and he may not be released on bail.

Arguments heard. Perusal of file reflects that in present case accused Shamsher Singh alleged to have committed offence U/s. 61-1-14 of Excise Act. Perusal of the police record shows that a large quantity of lahan has been recovered from the possession of the accused. So, it is made clear that the accused has committed the said offence is very serious in nature. Therefore, in considered view accused cannot be granted relief of bail. Hence, bail application stands declined.
