(Jigar Parshottambhai Siddhapura Vs. State of Gujarat)

ORDER BELOW EXH.1:

1. Heard Ld.Advocates for the parties.
2. This application u/o.33 R-1,2 of CPC is filed seeking permission to file main application for compensation as indigent person. It is stated that the applicant's income is used to meet with the expenses of the Treatment / family and he has no capacity to pay the Court fees and he has movable / immovable property worth Rs.800/-. The applicant has also produced Schedule vide Ex.3 and applicant has filed affidavit to this effect vide Exh.2 respectively and affirmed the pleading made in the petition. The formal reply/objection by opponent/State is filed vide Exh.-10.
3. Considering the weak condition and plight of the applicant as stated in this application, he can not be prevented access to justice. In this view, following order is passed:-

-: O R D E R :-

The applicant is permitted to file the claim petition in pauperism on condition that the after declaration of the award and the amount being deposited, the requisite Court fees shall be deducted. The Registry is directed to register the claim petition for its adjudication according to law.
