-: ORDER :-

- (1) Herein, MACP No.211/2019 has been decided by Judgment and Award on 17.11.2025 and concerned opponent has deposited the amount as per Award. Therefore, claimant has preferred present application to withdraw the deposited amount of award.
- (2) At the time of recording the Award, the Tribunal has passed the following order:

“5. If any amount is paid U/s 140 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 then that amount shall be deducted from the awarded amount.

6. Under section 168(3) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, opponents shall deposit said awarded amount with interest as held above within 30 days from the date of this order.

7. Nazir is hereby directed to deduct the amount of court fee if it is leviable from the claimants.

8. The order as regard disbursement be made at the time of withdrawal of amount.”

- (3) Thereafter, the concerned Clerk has made an endorsement that on verification of the Writ Register, it is found that no appeal has been preferred in the matter. Same time, statement has been made in the petition that insurance company has not preferred any appeal or miscellaneous application or delay application before the Hon'ble High Court and the applicant has not received notice of the same.
- (4) Ld. Advocate for the otherside has endorsed his no objection for payment of the amount.
- (5) The Nazir has endorsed on 29.01.2026 that the amount of Rs.15,65,602/- stands credited in this petition vide Register “C” No.289 dated 11.2.2026.
- (6) It is pertinent to note that the claim petition was filed in the year 2019 which was decided in the year 2025 and therefore, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it would be just and proper that **30%** shall be disbursed in **cash** whereas remaining **70%** amount shall be placed in **FDR** with usual terms and conditions.
- (7) Therefore, considering the amount, considering the Award of the Tribunal and in view of the above, the following

disbursement order is passed and the present application stands disposed off accordingly.

₹ 15,65,602/-	The amount deposited to satisfy the award.
Rupees Fifteen Lakhs Sixty Five Thousand Six Hundred Two Only	
₹ 7,500/-	Be recovered towards the deficit Court Fee Stamp and to be Credited to the Government.
Rupees Seven Thousand Five Hundred Only	
₹ 15,58,102/-	Remaining Amount be disbursed to the claimant.
Rupees Fifteen Lakhs Fifty Eight Thousand One Hundred Two Only	
<u>OUT OF WHICH</u>	
₹ 4,67,431/-	NEFT/RTGS Be paid to the Applicant through NEFT/RTGS mode in his/her bank account after proper verification and identification.
Rupees Four Lakhs Sixty Seven Thousand Four Hundred Thirty One Only	
₹ 10,90,671/-	FDR Be Invested as Fixed Deposit in any Nationalized Bank of his/her choice in the name of Applicant for a period of Five (5) Years
Rupees Ten Lakhs Ninety Thousand Six Hundred Seventy One Only	

- The above investment be made with the following conditions:
 - No loan, overdraft or advance known by any other name or nomenclature, shall be made available on the said fixed deposit investment, and the Bank shall not allow any encumbrance on the said fixed deposit without written Order of this Tribunal.
 - The interest on the fixed deposit as and when it becomes due, shall be paid to the applicant/s on

monthly basis.

- The Bank shall intimate to the Tribunal the particulars of the fixed deposit.
 - On maturity of the said FDR/s, the Bank shall disburse the amount in favour of the applicant/s without insisting any order of this Tribunal.
- Yadi be sent accordingly.
