:- ORDER :-

- (1) Herein, MACP No.230/2021 has been decided by way of Judgment and Award dated 14.11.2025 and concerned earlier the opponent has deposited less amount as per Award for which execution petition No.4/2026 was filed and pursuant to the service of notice of such execution petition, the opponent has deposited the deficit amount. Therefore, applicant has preferred present application to withdraw the deposited amount of award.
- (2) At the time of passing the Award, the Tribunal has passed the following order:

“(5) The opponents have to bear the entire cost of this petition according to their liability as decided herein above.

(6) The all interim orders shall merge into final order.

(7) If any amount is paid U/s.140 of the Motor Vehicle Act,1988 then that amount shall be deducted from the awarded amount.

(8) Under Sec.168(3) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, opponents no.3-insurer shall deposit the awarded amount with interest, as held above, within 30 days from the date of this order.

(9) Nazir is hereby directed to deduct the amount of court fee if it is leviable from the claimants.

(10) The order as regard disbursement be made at the time of withdrawal of amount.”

(3) This Tribunal has passed following order at Exh.1:-

“The applicant/applicants shall furnish following information immediately :-

1. Whether appeal has been preferred by either party?
2. Whether any stay order against execution of award of the Higher Court is there?

And further the Senior Clerk, M.A.C.T. Branch shall have endorsement of person concerned that whether any writ for filing of appeal has been received in this matter and whether any stay against execution of award is there or not ?”

(4) Thereafter, the concerned Clerk has made an endorsement on 11.06.2026 that no writ of the Hon'ble High Court is received since 14.11.2025 so far as present MACP is concerned and same time, statement has been made in the petition that no appeal has been preferred against the Judgment by the opponent insurer.

(5) The Advocate of the other side has made endorsement of ‘No Objection to payment of the amount’.

(6) The Nazir has endorsed on 15.06.2026 that amount of Rs.74,950/- stands credited in this petition vide “C” No.66 dated 15.06.2026. Nazir has further endorsed that

Rs.15,000/- stands deposited with the Government towards Court Fee.

- (7) Therefore, considering that the amount is the deficit amount of the awarded amount, it would be just and proper that the entire amount be disbursed in cash in favour of the applicant.
- (8) Therefore, in view of the above, the following disbursement order is passed and the present application stands disposed off accordingly.
