

**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT-1**

*(Kantilal Keshavjibhai Hadvani Vs. Hiteshbhai Devendrabhai Patel)*

1. The present M.A.C.P. is filed by the claimant under Section-166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, for getting the amount of compensation from the opponents on account of injuries sustained by claimant due to vehicular accident and the same is assigned to this court for disposal, in accordance with law.
2. Since last long, there is no progress in the matter. No attempts are made by the claimant side to expedite the matter and matter is pending about since 12 years and vide Exh.-17, Ld.Advocate for the claimant was granted adjournment to lead the evidence today but still then there is no progress in the matter.
3. Today, upto 17-00 Hrs., neither the applicant nor their Advocate proceed further in the matter before this Court. Even no adjournment application is submitted from either side. Therefore, it seems that claimant is not interested in continuing the proceedings of the present claim petition. Hence, at this stage, this Tribunal thinks fit to dismiss the present Claim Case No.717/2005 of the applicant.
4. Thus, in view of the above position, this court has no alternative, but to pass the following order:-
