The cognizance of the offence is already taken by the Virtual Court and a fine was proposed for summary disposal of case as per Section 208 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988. The violator has exercised option to contest the challan on web portal of virtual traffic courts and the challan is transferred to this court for further adjudication as per law.

At this stage, accusation is explained to the accused in vernacular language. Accused submits that he wishes to plead guilty for the offence **u/s 184 M.V. Act, 1988**. Accused is apprised about the consequences of pleading guilty and the fact that he can be convicted for the offence. Accused submits that he has understood the consequences and wants to plead guilty.

It is prayed by Accused that a lenient view may be taken against him and also prays for a lesser amount of fine stating that he will be careful in future and will not repeat the same offence.

Keeping in view the plea of guilt of offence by the accused, accused is convicted for offence **u/s 184 M.V. Act, 1988. Convict is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1000/- and in default SI of 03 days.**

Convict is directed to pay fine by way of payment on web portal of the court i.e. <https://pay.ecourts.gov.in>. It is submitted by the convict that he has paid the fine of **Rs.1000/-** on the said portal. The same is reflecting on CIS.

The present challan is hereby disposed of. Original documents, if any, impounded with the Traffic Circle be returned to the rightful owner as per rule.
