

**IN THE MOTOR ACCIDENT CLAIM TRIBUNAL[AUX.]
& 2ND ADDITIONAL DISTRICT COURT,
JUNAGADH AT KESHOD.**

1. The Decree Holder, HDFC ERGO General Insurance Co. Ltd., has preferred the present application vide **Exh.-06** under Order XXI Rule 6 read with Section 39 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the decree for execution.
2. It is submitted by the Decree Holder that the Judgment Debtor, M/s P.N.X. Logistics Pvt. Ltd., is having its office/address at 4C, Western Express Highway, Navapada, Airport Authority Colony, Vile Parle, Mumbai - 400047. Consequently, the Decree Holder has prayed to transfer the said decree to the court of competent jurisdiction in Mumbai.
3. Further, a Pursis vide Exhibit-07 has been submitted, declaring that the Judgment-Debtor resides at Vile Parle, Mumbai, which falls under the territorial jurisdiction of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal,

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT) Court,
Mumbai.

4. The learned Advocate for the Decree Holder is present and has argued that the decree needs to be transferred to the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT) Court, Mumbai on the ground that the assets and properties of the Judgment Debtor are located within the territorial jurisdiction of that Tribunal.
5. Upon perusal of the record, this Tribunal has verified the facts and arrived at the conclusion that the properties of the Judgment Debtor sought to be attached are located outside the territorial jurisdiction of this Tribunal. Therefore, the present application deserves to be allowed.

-:: O R D E R ::-

1. The Application filed by the Decree Holder vide Exh. 06 is hereby allowed.
2. The Registry is directed to forward the Decree along with (1) Certified copy of the Decree (2) Affidavit of the Decree Holder verifying the facts as per Order XXI Rule 11(2) of the CPC (3) Vakalatnama (4) Certificate

of Non-Satisfaction of the Decree (under Section 41 of the CPC) to the competent Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT) Court, Mumbai for execution, in accordance with the law.

3. No order as to costs.
