:: J U D G M E N T ::

1. The present application is preferred by the applicant/accused person under section 483 of the B.N.S.S. 2023 for releasing him on regular bail in connection with Keshod Police Station vide Cri. Reg. No.11203030260120/2026 for the offences punishable u/s 64(2)(M),140(4),115(2) and 351(3) of B.N.S.
2. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant would submit that the accused is innocent but falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant in jail for indefinite period. It is further contended that the applicant is ready and willing to abide by all the conditions that may be imposed by this Court if released on bail.
3. As against the same, Ld. A.P.P. appearing for the respondent-State has vehemently objected to the grant of regular bail. Further Ld. APP has submitted that looking to the nature of offence and the role attributed to the present applicant, this Court may not exercise the discretion in favour of the applicant and the application may be dismissed.

Perused the affidavit of I.O. at Exh.06.

4. Heard Ld. Advocates appearing for the respective parties and perused the papers.
5. Having regard to the facts of this case, in order to decide this regular bail application u/S. 483 of the B.N.S.S. 2023, established principles as to bail have been taken into consideration. Rape is heinous crime. The applicant has past criminal record. The applicant/accused abducted the victim girl for unnatural lust. He openly tied the victim with string, dragging her in his car and took her to Valvadi farm house at Mendarda. Then he often committed rape on the victim and then gave criminal intimidation to the victim's brother. Police papers show there is also eye witness of such abduction besides the aggrieved herself. Considering the facts of the case, I am not incline to grant regular bail. Hence, I pass following Order :
