:: J U D G M E N T ::

1. This application is preferred by the applicant/accused person under section 483 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha

Sanhita,2023 for releasing him on regular bail in connection with offences punishable U/s. 108,85 and 54 of B.N.S., registered with Keshod Police Station vide Cr. No.11203030260006/2026.

2. Ld. Advocate for the applicant has argued that the applicant is husband of the deceased and there is no prima facie involvement of the applicant in alleged crime; that soon after suicide of deceased, the Keshod Police started A/mot inquiry No. 76/2025 and at that time the Father-Mother of the deceased had declared before Police officer concerned that they have settled the issue within family member and they don't blame any one for cause of suicide; that applicant is innocent and trial of this case will take time hence considering aspect of 'no pre-trial punishment', the applicant may be granted bail.
3. As against the same, Ld. A.P.P. appearing for the respondent-State has vehemently objected to the grant of regular bail. Further Ld. APP has submitted that looking to the nature of offence and the role attributed to the present applicant, this Court may not exercise the discretion in favour of the applicant and the application may be dismissed.

Perused the affidavit of I.O. vide Exh-07.

4. Having regard to the facts of this case, in order to decide this regular bail application u/S 483 of the B.N.S.S. 2023 established principles as to bail have been taken into consideration. In case of abetment to suicide the prosecution has to establish mens-rea of the accused to commit the offence and has to establish proximate link. The co-accused of this case have been enlarged on regular bail on merits. The police papers reveal that when the victim committed suicide, the applicant was not at his residence. The investigation is now over and Charge-sheet is filed. At the time of previous bail application the first informant had raised objections against this application stating that the applicant committed murder of deceased by throttling and Police had not investigated in the matter fairly. Upon inquiring from Doctor who did Post-mortem has opined the death of victim to be suicidal death. In view of time factor involved in completion of judicial process, if the accused is not granted bail, then that would be levying Pre-trial punishment to him. Hence, I pass following order :

::: O R D E R :::

This Criminal Misc. (Reg. Bail) Application No.83 of 2026 stands **allowed**.

The **applicant/accused person Nareshbhai Keshubhai Jadav**, of Criminal Misc. (Reg. Bail) Application No.83 of 2026, resident of the address shown in the cause title, is hereby **released on bail on furnishing personal bond of**

Rs.10,000/- and one surety of like amount, subject to following conditions that :

1. *To appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon by the Investigating Officer and to co-operate him in investigation;*
2. *Not to tamper with evidence or influence the witnesses concerned;*
3. *The applicant / accused person must remain present during the judicial proceedings against him on each occasion before the Court without fail;*
4. *Not to leave the territory of Gujarat State until completion of trial against him.*
5. *To surrender his passport, if any, and if the applicant does not own a passport, he must declare the same on affidavit.*
6. *The applicant/accused person must not indulge in similar or any other criminal offence.*

Bail is to be given before the concerned Court where judicial proceeding is pending.

The Copy of this Order be sent to Jail Authority for intimation to the Accused. Yadi of this Order be sent to Jail Authority through E-mail for it's compliance.
