ORDER BELOW EX.01

1. The applicant has preferred the present settlement/withdrawal pursis at Exh.13. The applicants have now reached an amicable settlement with the heirs of the driver and the owner of the vehicle bearing registration No. GJ-11-BC-7725.
2. Applicant attained the age of majority, has personally signed the withdrawal pursis and expressed his consent to unconditionally withdraw the claim petition.
3. In view of the settlement reached between the parties and the statement made in the pursis, the present claim petition is hereby **disposed of as withdrawn.**
4. As the matter is being settled and withdrawn in the Lok Adalat, refund of the Court Fees is considered. In accordance with Section 21 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987, and the relevant Court Fee Rules, the Registry is directed to issue a Certificate for Refund of Court Fees to the Applicant, after due verification.
5. No order as to costs.

6. Award be drawn accordingly.
