ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 130

1. Accused Sutreja has filed many prior applications. His jail transfer application Cr.M.A. #252/2020, 05/03/2021; Cr.M.A. #207/2020, 05/11/2020 – were dismissed by the court one after another. Those were detail six and three page Order. Sutreja under one or other reason wanted jail transfer. He was declined. Then Sutreja filed regular bail application. That was dismissed amidst observations that he had jumped bail and was directed by co-ordinate court to pay the fine of Rs.10000/-¹. Thereafter Sutreja complained about jail food. This court then passed an Order below Exhibit 118 (26/07/2021).
2. That does not end the matter. Now Sutreja wants “Faral” (meaning special food for religious occasions). He again files a

two page hand written application on A4 size white paper. He threatens to resort to fasting if he is not accommodated.

3. Past demeanor of Sutreja shows that he is habitually filing applications and tendering them in the court. He may continue to do so, for in a democratic republic people have a right to apply.
4. However, since Sutreja threatens fasting, this time the Jail authority is directed to look into jail manual and ensure that no jail indiscipline is permitted. Jail transfer should NOT be permitted since it will incentivize indiscipline, as already observed by this court in the referred two Cr.M.A. (supra).
5. Following Order follows:

ORDER

- Application by Accused Jitu alias Jagdish Sutreja (Exhibit 130, SC #100/2017) is disposed off with a direction to the Registry of the court to:
 - Send copy of this Order to the Jail authority;
 - Send copy of Sutreja's hand-written application at Exhibit 130 to Jail authority.
- Jail authority shall ensure that no Jail indiscipline by any jail inmate is permitted.
