14.11.2019        A surrender cum bail petition on behalf of **petitioner accused namely Sujeet Kumar Singh S/o - Late Dineshwar Prasad Singh** in connection with Saharsa P. S. Case No. 790/19 u/s - 341, 323, 384,427/34 of Indian Penal Code was moved today. Petitioner is taken into custody.

Heard the learned counsel Sri Manoranjan Ghosh for the petitioner and the learned D.P.O I/C Sri A.K.Roy for the State.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence at all and has falsely implicated in this case out of grudge, malice and due to dirty village politics. The anticipatory bail application of this petitioner accused has been disposed of by the Learned Sessions Judge, Saharsa vide A.B.A. No. 654/19 dated 23.10.19 with direction to surrender before the court below within four weeks from the date of order. It has further been stated that the case has been compromised between the parties and the compromise petition along with permission petition has filed. All the alleged sections are bailable except section - 384 I.P.C. which is added to make the offence graver and non-bailable. Petitioner is man of means and there is no chance of his absconding and tampering of the evidence of this case. Lastly, it is prayed that petitioner may be released on bail.

The learned D.P.O I/C has conceded the fact that the case has been compromised between the parties.

Perused the record. From perusal of record it appears that petitioner is named in this case u/s - 341, 323, 384,427/34 of Indian Penal Code. Both the parties have made compromise and supported the factum of compromise. Informant is present before the Court and supported the factum of compromise.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as compromise the bail petition dated 14.11.19 of above petitioner accused is allowed and directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each with additional

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condition that (i) the petitioner shall not indulge in any criminal activities in future (ii) petitioner shall not induce or threat to the witnesses during the course of investigation (iii) petitioner shall co-operate with the police during course of investigation whenever it is required by the police.
