Sub: **Application for return of passport under Section 483(1)(b) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.**

ORDER BELOW EXH.1:-

- 1) The present application has been filed by the applicant under Section 483(1)(b) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking return of his passport for the purpose of issuance of a new passport to his daughter.
- 2) Learned Advocate for the applicant has made submission as per

the facts and grounds mentioned in the application. It is further submitted that the applicant requires his original passport, which is deposited before the learned Trial Court, for the limited purpose of producing the same before the Regional Passport Authority for issuance of a new passport to his daughter. It is also submitted that the applicant is ready and willing to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. Therefore, he has prayed that the present application be allowed.

- 3) Learned A.P.P. for the State has submitted that as per the opinion of the Police Inspector, Kapadwanj Town Police Station, the passport may returned to the applicant on an interim basis.
- 4) I have heard the learned Advocate for the applicant as well as learned A.P.P. for the State and have perused the record of the case.
- 5) Upon considering the rival submission of both the sides and on perusal of the record, it appears that the applicant requires his passport only for the purpose of issuance of a new passport to his daughter. The application is not opposed by the other side. Therefore, this Court is of the opinion that the present application deserves to be allowed by imposing suitable conditions. Hence, the following order is passed.

ORDER

- This application is hereby allowed.
- The learned Trial Court is hereby directed to return the original passport bearing No.Y1517594 to the applicant - Vasim @ Mirchi Iqbalbhai Mirza on interim custody, after proper verification and identification, for the limited purpose of producing the same before the Regional Passport Authority for issuance of a new passport to his daughter.
- The applicant shall deposit Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) before the concerned Court as security prior to receiving the passport. If any amount is already lying deposited to his credit, the same shall be treated as compliance of this condition, subject to verification.
- The applicant shall re-deposit the original passport before the learned Trial Court immediately after completion of the process of issuance of a new passport to his daughter.
- The applicant shall not leave the territory of India without prior permission of the Court.
- This order be intimated to the concerned Court, for information and necessary action.
