

ORDER BELOW CLAIM PETITION IN M.A.C. PETITION No.249/2024

1. Ld. Advocate for the Parties have produced Compromise pursis. The same is recorded and accepted.
2. The Ld. Advocate for the claimant and opponent Insurance Company/ Companies have entered into compromise settling the claim as per compromise pursis. Thus, this Tribunal is of the opinion that the settlement arrived between the parties is legal and within the purview of subject matter of the claim petition and also in the interest of claimants. The compromise is, therefore, recorded accordingly. Hence, following order is passed:

:: ORDER ::

1. As per Compromise pursis, Opponent Insurance company is hereby directed to deposit the amount of **Rs.12,00,000/-** in the office of this Tribunal towards full & final compensation as settled, after deducting the amount of interim compensation, if any paid U/Sec.140 of M.V. Act, within three month from the date of this order. Other opponents are hereby exonerated.
2. The office shall not deduct or recover the amount of Court fees from the awarded amount deposited with this Tribunal, as the matter is compromised in Lok-Adalat .
3. Court Fees Refund Certificate, as the case may be, issued in the name of the claimant, if claimant has paid Court fees, if any. The awarding amount shall be disbursed to applicants equally.
4. Out of the amount payable to the major claimant, Rs. 2,00,000/- be paid to the claimants in cash by way of RTGS/ NEFT. Thereafter out of the remaining amount, 60% be paid to the claimants in cash by way of RTGS/ NEFT and the remaining 40% be invested in Fixed Deposit in any Nationalized Bank as per the choice of the claimants for a period of six years.
5. The Fixed Deposit be made with the condition that the claimants shall not be entitled to get any loan or advance or to create any burden upon such deposits. However, the claimants are entitled to withdraw the periodical interest upon the deposit.
6. The Bank Authority is directed to pay the amount to the claimant on maturity of such deposit, without any further order of the Tribunal.
7. The Parties shall bear their own costs.

8. Award be drawn up accordingly
9. In view of the above, the present claim petition stands disposed off accordingly as compromised in Lok-Adalat of 14th March, 2026.
