

Order Below Exh.1 :-

- (1) Claimant, alongwith his/her Ld. Advocate, and Ld. Advocate for the insurance company remained present in the matter and submitted compromise purshis at **Exh.18**. The claimant and insurance company – opponent no.2 settled the claim petition as per terms and conditions of the said pursis. The contents of said purshis have already been read over and explained to them and all the contents alongwith their respective signatures admitted by them. It seems that parties arrived at compromise purshis willingly and with their free consent. Thus they have arrived at compromise to settle the claim for **Rs.4,30,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Thirty Thousand only)**.
- (2) Further, it is also mentioned in the compromise pursis that the insurance company has received medical bills worth Rs.87,122/- from the claimant.
- (3) As per Section 21 of the Legal Service Authority Act, 1987 where a compromise or settlement has been arrived at, by a Lok Adalat in case referred on it under sub-section (1) of Section 20, the Court fee paid in such case shall be refunded in the manner provided under the Court Fees Act, 1870 (7 of 1870)
- (4) In view of the compromise pursis, I pass the following order.

:: ORDER ::

1. This claim petition is disposed of as per compromise at Exh.18.

2. As per the settlement, the claimant is entitled to get amount of **Rs.4,30,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Thirty Thousand only)** as compensation from the insurance company – opponent no.2 and the claim petition is disposed off against the opponent no.1.
3. The insurance company shall deposit the aforesaid amount within 3 (three) months from the date of settlement and default therefore the insurance company shall be liable to pay interest @ 6% on the above amount from the date of default till the realization.
4. The amount of interim compensation, if any paid, be deducted from the final amount of the award.
5. From the remaining amount, full medical bills i.e. Rs.87,122/- shall be paid to the applicant by A/c. Payee cheque or through NEFT / RTGS.
6. From the remaining amount, 50% amount be paid to the claimant/s through NEFT / RTGS, after due verification of the claimant/s and remaining 50% amount be kept in Fix Deposit in any Nationalized Bank in the name of claimant/s for the period of 5 (Five) years and the claimants are entitled to have periodically interest thereon.
7. Court Fee refund Certificate, be issued in the name of the claimant, if any paid.
8. No order as to costs.
9. Award be drawn accordingly.
