**O R D E R**

1. Anticipatory bail application of 438 Cr.P.C. has been moved on behalf of applicant/accused Rupinderjit Kaur for offences under Sections 420, 201, 120-B of IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional Regulation Act.
2. Notice of the bail application was given to the State.
3. Police record has been received.

4. Arguments have been heard and record has been perused.

5. Complainant Sandeep Kaur w/o Sukhwinder Singh moved a written complaint to the Police against Bharpoor Singh and Rupinderjit Kaur sister of Bharpoor Singh on the allegations that husband of the complainant was working in Dubai. Pawanjeet Singh son of the complainant, who has done 10+2, met Bharpoor Singh who assured Pawanjeet Singh to send him abroad. On 08.12.2023, accused Bharpoor Singh came to the house of complainant. Complainant told accused Bharpoor Singh that her son Pawanjeet Singh wanted to go to America and asked accused about the total expenditure for the same. Accused demanded Rs.17 Lacs for Visa and setting. Complainant gave Rs.1,80,000/- in cash and then Rs.35,000/- in cash to accused and she also transferred Rs.1,53,000/- in the account of Rupinder Kaur sister of accused Bharpoor Singh. Accused took the passport and other documents of Pawanjeet Singh but thereafter, accused neither sent Pawanjeet Singh to America nor returned the money to complainant and in this way, accused cheated the complainant.

6. Learned counsel for applicant/accused vehemently contended that applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the present case and all the allegations levelled in the FIR are absolutely false and cooped up by the complainant. The entire case is based on documentary evidence. Applicant/accused has not committed any offence as alleged by the complainant and

therefore, custodial interrogation of applicant/accused is not required and she be granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

7. The arguments so advanced on behalf of applicant/accused Rupinderjit Kaur are without force as there are specific allegations against accused persons including applicant/accused Rupinderjit Kaur that they enticed the complainant to send his son abroad and for such purpose, accused demanded Rs.17,00,000/- from complainant. Complainant gave Rs.1,80,000/- and Rs.35,000/- in cash to accused and then complainant also transferred Rs.1,53,000/- in the account of Rupinder Kaur sister of accused Bharpoor Singh. Accused took the passport and other documents of Pawanjeet Singh but thereafter, accused neither sent son of complainant to America nor returned the money to complainant and in this way, accused cheated the complainant. Even enquiry was conducted in the case and accused was found involved in the case. Prima-facie it appears that applicant/accused along with co-accused dishonestly cheated the complainant and therefore, at this stage, it cannot be said that applicant/accused has no role in the alleged crime and as such by considering all these things, applicant/accused is certainly not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail as her custodial interrogation is required in the present case in order to reach at the root of the case and to recovery the amount. Accordingly, present anticipatory bail application of applicant/

accused Rupinderjit Kaur is dismissed being without merits. Police record be returned forthwith and bail application file be consigned to record room.
