ORDER BELOW EXH- 44

Today, Plaintiff, P.O.A. holder of the plaintiff, the defendant no.1 to 5 and their Ld. Advocates have remained present before this court and they have presented a compromise agreement vide Exh-44 and thereby requested to pass necessary order and decree. They have admitted before the Court that parties have made compromise of their disputes in respect of suit matter. They have also admitted that they have executed this compromise agreement by their free and express consent.

Looking to the aforesaid facts of the case, it appears that parties have made compromise of their disputes and they admitted the contents of the compromise agreement. Therefore, there are no reasons for not relying or disbelieving the said facts.

Moreover, looking to the provision of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, there seems no legal bar to make compromise in respect of the present suit. Therefore, relying on the present compromise agreement, following order is passed in the interest of justice:

Order

This suit is hereby disposed off in view of Order-23, rule-3 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

Decree shall be drawn in terms of compromise agreement.

No order as to cost.

Court fee refund certificate as per rule be issued in the name of plaintiff.
