

- Order Below Exh-1 -

The plaintiffs and defendants of this suit along with their Advocates by remaining present in the court have filed compromise deed vide Exh-12 mentioning interalia that dispute between them has been resolved by way of settlement. Further, parties have filed compromise deed mentioning interalia that parties have settled their dispute and have decided to bound by the terms narrated in the compromise pursis, which was voluntarily accepted by both the parties before the court as mentioned in the compromise pursis. Hence, neither party is desirous to proceed further with the suit and declared to dispose of the suit.

Therefore, looking to the facts and submission of the parties, the consent terms in form of present compromise pursis is taken on record and this Court hereby passes following order below Exh-1 in the interest of justice.

- ORDER -

1. In view of the compromise pursis at Exh-12 this suit stands disposed off as compromised.
2. The consent decree to be drawn accordingly.
3. There shall be no order as to cost.
4. All pending applications to be disposed of accordingly.
