[1] The brief facts of the case is that on 12.09.2025 at around 17:30 hrs Saputara check Post, Public road, the accused was found driving a Motorcycle with a RTO No. Of GJ-30-C-7502, under the influence of alcohol without a valid permit or pass in public, which is illegal. Thus, the accused was caught in this condition and thereby committed an offense under Section 185 of the Motor Vehicle Act.

[2] In this case the accUsed appeared before the court. After confirming that the accused receive the police investigation documents, the plea of the accused was recorded wherein the accused pleaded guilty. The accuused voluntarily submitted a plea of guilty and stated that he admits the offense without any caution of threat. He belongs to a poor family and this is his first offense. Hence, he requests mercy and an apporprate.

Considering the facts of the case, the accused's economic condition, his volunatry admission of guilt and the guildlines laid down by he Honble Gujarat High Court in State of Gujarat vs. Natwar Harichandji GLR 2005, (1) Page 709, the following order is passed in the interest of justice, by imposing minimum punishment prescribed and fine.

:: Final Order ::

1. The accused is convicted for the offence of Section 185 of Motor Vehicle Act and Section 66 (1)(b) of the Gujarat Prohibition Act under Section 264 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. The accused is ordered to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- for the offence of Section 185 of Motor Vehicle Act and Rs. 100/- for the offence of Section 66 (1)(b) of the Gujarat Prohibition Act. The accused shall under go simple imprisonment of 10 days if failed to pay fine.
2. The accused is required to pay total fine of Rs. 600/- (Six Hundred only).
