Counsel for plaintiff submits that he has already supplied the copy. In view of the same, **the right of the defendant to make submissions with respect to the application stands closed.**

Since a clerical mistake was made, the plaintiff is

permitted to re-exhibit the documents i.e. **Ex. PW1/1 to Ex. PW1/10**. The said documents are now re-exhibited and the same shall be considered for appreciation of evidence.

At this stage, again, the proxy counsel is making submissions without switching on the video and therefore, this Court is compelled to expel the counsel from VC.

PW-1 is further examined with respect to the affidavit filed u/s 63 BSA. Cross examination is deferred.
