**Order Below application Exh.-25**

1. The ld. advocate on behalf of Reliance General Insurance Company Ltd, i.e. the opponent No.3 has preferred present application to delete the opponent No.3 as necessary party.
2. The ld. advocate of opponent No.3 has stated that the accident was occurred on 31.03.2022 at about 01:00 p.m. As per policy produced on record by the applicant, policy issued for the period commencing from dtd.01.04.2022 to 31.03.2023. The vehicle number is not mentioned in the complaint as well as in the chargesheet. The applicant has not produced panchnama on the record. Thus, the applicant has failed to establishment involvement of vehicle in question. Thus, he has requested to delete the opponent No.3 as necessary party.
3. It transpires from the record, that insurance policy of offending vehicle issued by Reliance General Insurance Company Ltd for the period from dtd.01.04.2022 to 31.03.2023. The accident was occurred on 31.03.2022. The applicant has not produced insurance policy covered the date of accident, which issued by the opponent No.3. Therefore, in absence of any documentary evidence, the opponent No.3 is not required to be stood as necessary party. In view of above, the application is deserves to be

allowed. Hence, I pass the following order:

**:ORDER:**

- The application Exh.-25 is hereby allowed.
- The opponent No.3-Reliance General Insurance Company Ltd, is hereby deleted as party.
- Necessary amendment be made in the petition Exh.-1 and amendment petition shall be produced forthwith.
- No order as to costs.
