Arguments on bail application, heard. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has submitted that applicant-accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the alleged recovery shown by the police is false and planted and applicant-accused has been falsely implicated in order to strengthen a fabricated case. It is stated that the applicant-accused was arrested on 11.04.2026 in connection with the present FIR. It is further stated *that no such application has been decided or pending in any Court/District Court/High Court.*

On the other hand, Ld. APP for the state has orally submitted that offence is serious, so application may be dismissed.

Considered. The accused is in custody since his arrest. The presentation of challan and its trial will take long time and no useful purpose will be served to keep the accused behind the bars. Keeping in view the custody of the applicant/accused and above said circumstances, the bail application is allowed. Applicant/accused Amandeep Singh son of Gurmail Singh resident of village Kotla, Tehsil Samrala, District

Ludhiana is admitted on bail on furnishing bail bonds in sum of Rs. 30,000/ with one surety in the like amount with an undertaking not to temper with the evidence of the prosecution and to appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing and not to leave the country without prior permission of the Court. Requisite bail bonds/surety bonds furnished, which are attested and accepted. Release warrants be issued forthwith. Papers be tagged with the connected file.
