


GJPM170016192025 	<u>Order below FDR application</u> <u>No.523/2025 Ex.1 in MAC</u> <u>Petition No.54/2022 settled in the</u> <u>National Lok Adalat of dated 18-</u> <u>12-2024</u>

1) The applicants have filed the present application seeking directions of this Tribunal to the Manager of State Bank of India, Pavagadh Road, Halol branch for premature release of FDR Account No.43933145164 for Rs.3,75,000/- of applicant no.1 and FDR Account No.43933529149 for Rs.3,75,000/- of applicant no.2, both for the period from 21-03-2025 to 21-03-2030. Admittedly, the present applicants were the claimants of Claim Petition No.54 of 2022 and opponent-insurer has deposited the total amount of compensation of Rs.16,50,000/-, wherefrom, the present applicants have received 40% amount in cash by way of account payee cheques and 60% amount i.e. Rs.7,50,000/- of their share has been invested in the said FDRs in their individual name for period from 21-03-2025 to 21-03-2030. Now, after death of their son, the claimants have sought order for premature withdrawal of those amounts to meet with the wedding ceremony expenses of their daughter namely, Jyotika which was going to be solemnized from 16-11-2025 to 18-11-2025 but the order of their present MACMA was not passed by the Tribunal, therefore, due to monetary crisis, they had postponed the wedding ceremony of their daughter, and therefore, now, they need money for the said purposes and to substantiate the averments, the applicants have filed their separate Affidavits vide Ex.4 & Ex.5 in support of the present application and produced original Invitation vide M-3/4 to be arranged the wedding ceremony of their daughter. According to the applicants, they have incurred huge amount towards medical treatment of their deceased son who died in a vehicular accident and except the said amount, they have no other means of income for said purposes,

therefore, they prayed for premature withdrawal of those FDRs amounts.

2) It clearly appears from the records that, the present applicants need money for the wedding ceremony expenses of their daughter namely, Jyotika which could not be solemnized from 16-11-2025 to 18-11-2025 as per original Invitation of M-3/4 due to their monetary crisis as they were awaiting for receiving the money of the present MACMA by the order of the Tribunal. Therefore, Considering the overall totality of the facts and circumstances and the separate affidavits filed by both the applicants that, the wedding ceremony of their daughter is going to be arranged now, and therefore, the reasons stated in the application appear to be genuine one, so, this Tribunal is of the view that present application for withdrawal of premature Fix Deposit Receipts deserves to be allowed. Hence, the following order is passed in the interest of justice.

ORDER

The present application for withdrawal of premature Fix Deposit Receipts stands **allowed**, considering the grounds, affidavits and supporting documents available on records, and thereby, it is ordered to pay entire total amount of Rs.7,50,000/-, with interest, if any, by A/c. Payee Cheque to the applicants upon proper identification and verification which have been invested in the FDR vide FDR Account No.43933145164 for Rs.3,75,000/- of applicant no.1 and vide FDR Account No.43933529149 for Rs.3,75,000/- of applicant no.2 for the period from 21-03-2025 to 21-03-2030 under order of the Tribunal.
