

ORDER BELOW EX.1 IN
M.A.C.M.A. No.113/2026

1. Read the application and heard the learned advocate for the applicant. The present application has been filed by the applicant for premature withdrawal of Fixed Deposit kept in the Bank in view of M.A.C.P. No.214/2017.
2. Applicant has submitted that, she was minor at the time of the disbursement order and hence her total proportionate amount was invested in the FDR. Now the applicant has turned major and her marriage shall take place soon and she has no other source of income. If present application is not granted, she cannot afford the expenditures of marriage. Hence the present application has been made seeking permission for premature withdrawal of her Fixed Deposit by the applicant.
3. Read the application and heard the learned advocate for the applicant and perused the record. The applicant has turned major and she needs money for her marriage. The applicant has produced her Aadhaar Card vide Mark-5/5, wherein her date of birth seems 05/05/2007 and hence she is major now. She has also submitted affidavit vide Ex.4 that she is major now and she needs money for her marriage. So looking to the facts and circumstance of the case, this Tribunal finds it appropriate to allow the present application. Looking to the record, no appeal has been filed against the order of the Tribunal in the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat. In view of above, following order is passed.

-:: ORDER ::-

1. The present Application is hereby **Allowed**.
2. Applicant is hereby permitted to withdraw the **whole amount** from the **FDR Account No.08410300047915** of Bank of Baroda, Market

Yard Branch, Patan lying in her name.

3. Yadi be made to the concerned Bank.
4. R&P, if any, be sent back with copy of this order.
