

ORDER BELOW EX.1 IN
M.A.C.M.A. No.114/2026

1. The present application is U/s. 169 of the M.V. Act for payment by the applicant in connection with M.A.C.P. No.52/2024. Read the application and heard the learned advocate for the applicant. I have gone through the endorsement of verification made by Nazir and 'No Objection' made by the learned advocate for the Insurance Company. Perusing the record, no appeal is filed against order of the Tribunal. This matter has been compromised in National Lok-Adalat, hence no court fees required to be deducted. The learned advocate for the insurance company has made endorsement of 'No Objection' to pay the amount of medical bills to the applicant in the compromise purshish. Hence the following order is passed.

-:: ORDER ::-

1. The present Application is hereby **Allowed**.
2. From the total amount of **Rs.4,00,000/- (Rs. Four Lac only)** lying in the FDR with the Tribunal, **Rs.45,900/-(Rs. Forty Five Thousand Nine Hundred only)** for medical bills be disbursed in favour of the applicant, and thereafter from the remaining amount, **50%** amount along with interest be disbursed in favour of the applicant through RTGS/NEFT in his/her bank account after due verification and **50%** amount be invested as Fixed Deposit in the name of the applicant for a period of **five** years in any Nationalized Bank as per applicant's choice.
3. Order of Fixed Deposit follows these conditions:
 - (1) *Applicant shall not be permitted premature loan, withdrawal or any kind of encumbrance over the said Fixed Deposit Receipt as well as Concerned Bank shall not give Duplicate Fixed Deposit Receipt.*
 - (2) *Applicant shall be entitled to get the periodical*

interest accrued from time to time on the aforesaid Fixed Deposit amount as per rules.

- (3) *At the time of maturity of F.D.R., Concerned Bank shall pay deposited amount and accrued interest, if any, to the applicant without order of this Tribunal.*
