

**ORDER BELOW CHARGE-SHEET Exh.01 of SESSIONS CASE
NO. 28 OF 2026.**

1. I have perused the R & P of above Session Case. It appears that the above Sessions Case has been instituted on Police report for the offence punishable u/s. 64(1), 351(3) of the Indian Penal Code and also u/s. 135 of the Gujarat Police Act registered with Siddhpur Police Station A part Cr. No. 11217030251100 of 2025. On conclusion of investigation against accused Kanubhai Mafabhai Devipujak, Age about 40 years, occupation : Labour, residing at : Ganwada, Indiraparur, Taluka : Siddhpur, District : Patan the police has filed charge-sheet and accordingly the present sessions case is instituted. During the pendency of the present case the accused Kanubhai Mafabhai Devipujak has preferred an application being Criminal application (for consent quashing) No. 14267 of 2026 for quashing of the impugned FIR being A part Cr. No. 11217030251100 of 2025 registered with Siddhpur (Patan District) Police Station for the said offence and vide an order dated 25.06.2026 the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat pleased to pass following order.

"12. In the result, the present application is allowed. The FIR being Cr. No. 1127030251100 of 2025 registered with Siddhpur (Patan District) Police Station , as well as all consequential proceedings arising there from, are hereby quashed and set aside qua the applicant.

2. As the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat so far as present accused concerned has quashed the FIR being A part 11217030251100 of 2025 registered with Siddhpur (Patan District) Police Station, the writ of Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat is produced at Ex.08 and as Hon'ble High court has also quashed all other consequential proceedings arising from the said FIR and accordingly also quashed present Sessions Case arisen from the said FIR is hereby disposed of in view of order passed by Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat in Cri. Misc. Application (for consent quashing) No. 14267 of 2026. The

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accused is accordingly set at liberty and bail bond are canceled and sureties are discharged.

3. The non-valuable Muddamal Article is hereby ordered to be destroyed after completion of appeal period.

4. File shall be consigned in record room as per the Rules.
