

ORDER BELOW EX.1

1. Read the application and heard the learned advocate for the applicant. The present application has been filed by the applicant for premature withdrawal of Fixed Deposit kept in Bank in view of M.A.C.P. No.120/2015.
2. Applicant has submitted that his financial condition is not good and he borrowed money from his friends and relatives for his expenses and his marriage is fixed and he has no money to meet the expenses of his marriage. The applicant has no other arrangement of money except his FDR amount and if the present applicant is granted, he would be in trouble and if the present application is allowed, it would provide a relief to the applicant. Hence the present application has been preferred by the applicant seeking permission for premature withdrawal of his Fixed Deposit.
3. Read the application and heard the learned advocate for the applicant and perused the record. The applicant needs money for his marriage. He has no other option than his FDR amount. His marriage card is produced on record vide Mark-6/1. Hence if the present application is granted, it would be in the interest of justice. Looking to the record, no appeal has been filed against the order of the Tribunal in the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat. In view of above, following order is passed.

-:: ORDER ::-

1. Present Application is hereby **Allowed**.
2. Applicant is hereby permitted to withdraw **the whole amount** from the **FDR No.0809034 of Indian Bank, Patan** Branch lying in the name of the applicant.

3. Yadi be made to the concerned Bank.
4. R&P, if any, be sent back with copy of this order.
