

Order below exhibit 1

1. The present application is filed by the applicant under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 seeking various reliefs as contemplated under Sections 18 to 22 of the Act. Today, the applicant has appeared before the Court and has produced on record a settlement agreement arrived at between herself and the respondent before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP (Civil) No. 2722–2723 of 2025.
2. It is submitted by the applicant that in view of the aforesaid settlement, the disputes between the parties have been amicably resolved. The applicant has, therefore, tendered a withdrawal pursis stating inter alia that she does not desire to proceed further with the present proceedings. The said withdrawal pursis is taken on record vide exhibit 107. Upon due inquiry by this Court, the applicant has categorically stated that the settlement has been entered into voluntarily, without any coercion or undue influence, and that she does not wish to prosecute the present application any further.
3. In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the unequivocal statement made by the applicant, no cause survives for adjudication in the present proceedings. Hence, the following order is passed:

Final Order

1. The withdrawal pursis filed by the applicant at Exhibit 107 is hereby taken on record.

2. The present Criminal Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of as withdrawn in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP (Civil) No. 2722–2723 of 2025.
